Mary Therese Rose Crilly was born in 1998 with Joubert standers and funds activities such as horseback riding that Syndrome, a rare genetic disorder which left her profoundly disabled. Though physically limited, Mary's limitless love and courage inspired those closest to her to establish a fund in her name to benefit special needs children being treated at The Kireker Center for Child Development of The Valley Hospital. The Fund provides needed therapies and equipment that are too often denied by insurance companies due to lifetime benefit limits or denial of reasonable claims. Each year The Mary Therese Rose Fund helps pay for needed equipment like orthotics, braces, and

are not only therapeutic but also brighten the lives of these special kids. It is the goal of The Mary Therese Rose Fund to help these special children reclaim some of the simple joys of childhood denied them by their disabilities.

Though Mary passed away in 2003 her brief life was filled with joy. In gratitude, and to honor her memory, supporters of the Mary Therese Rose Fund continue to work so that other special children can experience some of childhood's simple joys as Mary did.


DIRECTIONS TO SPRING LAKE DAY CAMP

From 208 North/I-287 South

- 208 North to end and continue onto I-287 SOUTH. (208 North turns into 287 South).
- 0 Exit 57 I-287 (Ringwood/Skyline Drive) at end of exit ramp, make right onto Skyline Drive.
- Go 3 miles and make 1st left onto Conklintown Road.
- Spring Lake Day Camp is 1 mile on the right.

From I-287 North

- 287 North. Follow signs to Exit 55. Make right onto Ringwood Ave. (Braen Stone Supply on left).
- 3 miles take right onto Conklintown Road
- Spring Lake Day Camp is one mile on left.
